There were 56 fire prevention programs that reached 2,331 children and 1,282 adults.



FIRE INVESTIGATIONS

During 2007 there were 109 fire investigations with the following results:

- 25 found to be intentional
- 44 found to be unintentional
- 12 were undetermined
- 15 caused by equipment failure
- 5 still under investigation
- 4 act of nature
