



## Local Tax Withholding Earned Income Tax

### Easton City

Effective January 1, 2025

Effective January 1, 2025, the earned income tax (EIT) rate applicable to “non-resident” commuters is 1%. The non-resident EIT is levied on those who commute to work in Easton City. If the tax rates for the resident and workplace jurisdictions differ, employers must withhold at the higher of the two rates.

Your business must withhold from payroll and report employee EIT to Keystone in compliance with Pennsylvania law. Quarterly payroll withholding returns and payments are due within 30 days after the close of each calendar quarter. *Make your payment by the quarterly due date to avoid statutory penalty, interest and Act 192 costs.*

**Include the following information to ensure proper handling:**

**Earned Income Tax**

- Your Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN)
- Political Subdivision (PSD) Codes for both the workplace location and resident municipality of each employee
- Physical addresses for each employee (No PO Boxes permitted)
